Guidelines for Show:

- Market lamb and showmanship classes are open to youth 21 and under as of January 1, 2018. Breeding stock classes are open class.
- Showmanship offered for 6 yr & under w/mentor (peewee showmanship)
- Class premiums are prorated to top 4 in class.
- Market lambs will show by breed with a minimum of 5 needed for a breed except for white face class
- All sheep must have USDA Scrapie ID tags.
- Out of state sheep need interstate health papers.
- All lambs must be shorn within 5 days of show weigh-in.
- Lambs will show in the class they are assigned.
- Ewe lambs show as market or breeding stock
- Animals exhibiting fungus, soremouth or other contagious diseases are not allowed to show. Health inspector has final say at check in point.

Guidelines for Show

- Market hog and showmanship classes are open to youth 21 and under as of January 1, 2019.
- Showmanship offered for 6 yr & under w/mentor (peewee showmanship)
- Class premiums are prorated to top 4 in class.
- Out of state hogs need interstate health papers.
- Hogs will be shown by breed and weight. Barrows or gilts are eligible. Breed must be declared at the time weight cards are turned in.
- Registration papers will be checked at check-in. Breed/Weight division champions and reserves will be selected after every 4 to 5 classes. An overall champion and reserve champion will be selected. The Top Five Overall will be selected. Only division champion and reserve division champions are eligible.
- Hogs do not need a pseudo rabies test.
- Top two hogs in each class will be re-weighed for accuracy and must weigh within 10 pounds of reported weight. Any variance of more than 10 pounds will result in disqualification.
- Individuals entering more than one pig per exhibitor: Exhibitor may purchase only one (1) pen per every two hogs. If an individual pen is needed, exhibitor will be responsible for providing a divider panel.
