

Springport FFA & Agriscience Fair, Barn, and Equipment Agreement

Taking animals to fair

- Follow all fair rules (pen cleanout, take care of animals by 9am, give bedding, sweep out isle)
- Show pride reflective of our chapter while at the fair
- Do your **own** chores. If there is a conflict ask a friend to do your chores. Make it up to them
- Follow FFA's expectations for fair. All school rules are in affect (dress code)
- Keep complaints to yourself, have a positive attitude
- MUST volunteer for FFA at fair
- If staying at fair you must be at camper by 12 am
- MUST sign the guidelines with your parents before participating at fair

Keeping livestock in the Ag Barn

- Chores need to be done 2 times a day, Chore times Morning: By 9a.m., Night between 5-9p.m.
- Must sign barn usage agreement before livestock can be kept in barn
- Chores include: feeding, watering, bedding, and clean the barn
- If you miss more than 1 barn meeting without prior permission your animals will be removed from the barn within 24 hours.
- If you miss more than 1 chore time without pre-arrangement, animals must be removed from the barn within 24 hours. If they are not removed they will be hauled.
- No washing animals in barn
- Clip animals on cement, Clean up ALL messes.

Usage of barn equipment

- Text (preferred) or Call Henne or Merrill to let them know your using the equipment
- Must sign the equipment out (name, number, time In/Out)
- Clean & Disinfect it before it gets brought back to the barn
- Equipment must be brought back **within 24 hours** of taking it.
